Henceforth the application for seeking relaxations in terms of para 2.58 of <u>FTP 2015-20</u> under the EPCG committee would be accepted through online mode only. No manual submission of application for the same would be allowed. The member of the trade can login to the portal, fill the requisite of details in the form, upload the necessary documents and submit the application after paying requisite fees. The System will generate a file number which can be used for the tracking purposes through the portal. The Directorate would issue online deficiency letters calling by any additional information required and the exporter would be able to reply to the deficiency letter online. The entire processing of the application and communication of the decision of the committee would be in online mode only.
